

# **INFORMATION SHEET – Greenwich site works**

Riverlinx CJV are working on behalf of Transport for London to construct the Silvertown Tunnel. This notification is to update you on our progress this quarter and to notify of upcoming activities.

# What are we doing?

Ground preparation works are underway to facilitate the construction of the tunnel approaches and permanent works. Highways diversions will also take place in the next quarter. Further planned works are detailed below.

# West Parkside utility works – December 2021

Between Wednesday 08 and Friday 17 December 2021, we will be undertaking staged closures of West Parkside. This is to allow for utility diversions within the Northbound and Southbound carriageways. West Parkside will be closed \*directionally between John Harrison Way and Edmund Halley Way. A diversion will be in place and will be clearly signposted along Millennium Way. Closures will be between 06:00 and 18:00 each day for the duration of the works. \*Both carriageways will not be closed at the same time. # Decked car park works – until December 2021

We are continuing works to transform the existing coach park off Millennium Way (shown on map below) into a decked car park. Piling works are now complete. We will now start to build the steel structure which will form the frame of the decked car park, followed by fit out works and cladding. Extended hours may be used to complete steel and concrete works, only if required for engineering and safety reasons (please see the column overleaf). Noise and dust monitoring will be in place at all times.

#### Piling works – ongoing until January 2021

Piling works to construct the walls for the new tunnel entrance are underway in the Portal area. Once the walls are complete, the same activity will be carried out to construct the over bridge and the entrances to the Silvertown Tunnel portal approach. # Utilities surveys and installation - ongoing

Trial hole works to identify and locate buried utilities in the car park areas are now complete. Installation of a dewatering (an outfall) pipe is now underway from the car park area to Olympian Way. This will allow for discharge of water from future excavations.

#### Rotation chamber tunnel preparation – until March 2022

Pre-excavation and enabling works are ongoing to facilitate piling for the Silvertown Tunnel rotation chamber. Excavators are in operation and road vehicles will remove debris. The construction of the permanent wall foundations will commence in the coming months and the preparatory guide wall construction to direct this activity is ongoing. These works will take place within core hours listed in the right-hand column. Hours may be extended only if required for engineering and safety reasons, for example to safely complete a concrete pour.

#### Community Liaison Group meetings (CLG)

CLG meetings are held quarterly to provide an update to the community on construction progress, how we deliver our works and job and apprenticeship openings. It is an opportunity to ask questions directly to the Silvertown Tunnel team.
